- GPA must be 2.5 or higher
- Must be want to learn about money
- Must fill out a student profile
- Must take a the pre assessment
- Must be willing to do a monthly group presentation

HOW WILL IT WORK?

- We will have 9 sessions. Once per month until May 2017
- We will have coaches during each session. Carlyne is our coach coordinator
- A guest coach who specializes in the monthly financial subject will be invited
- In May, each one of you will be paired with a mentor. Sainte is our mentor coordinator
- You will be split in 3 groups
- Each group will have up to 7 minutes to present the monthly financial subject and get scored on a scale of 1 to 5
- “How does the Money Matters Mentorship help” essay. First draft due in February
